The change in terms of reference to the **Board of Health, Safety, and Environment**Committee to include student wellness was successful! On other news, there was also approval for a capital expenditure of \$74,000,000 to complete Lister Centre Tower #5 and to complete East Campus Village. The expansion of student housing is part of a larger vision for the UofA to be able to give guaranteed housing at the very least to students who live outside of Edmonton. This already exists at various other major universities in Canada including UBC, UVic, and UofT so we are definitely behind as a university by not already being able to provide this.
