

Faculty Association Membership Fee

(FAMF)

Background

- Used to help fund a variety of services and events run through the ESS
- Introduced in 2002 and has been renewed twice, once in 2006 and again in 2010
- To be renewed at minimum every four years



Amount & Lifetime - Proposed

- \$7.00 / student / on campus semester
- FAMF would generate approximately \$63,000 per year
- If accepted FAMF:
 - Begins September 1st 2016
 - Expires August 31st 2019
 - 3 year life




Opt-Out

- Every student has the right to opt out
- Students are reimbursed through the ESS through procedures laid out in the ESS policy manual
- Off-campus (includes co-op terms) and part-time students **do not** have to pay



- Allows for each first year engineering student to receive a bandana




The Bridge




Fees Charged at WESST Schools per Year
